Changes to the Human Gut Microflora

Bacterial load $\sim 3 \times 10^{11}$ (30 trillions) bacterial cells in a 70-kg healthy adult gut

Healthy intestinal microbial load is **stable** throughout adulthood

Healthy balance of the Bacteroidetes & Firmicutes - major bacterial groups (phyla)

Ageing process, perturbations occur with antibiotics & steroid uses and high carbohydrate diets and cellular stress

Fermentation processes in the colonic gut are altered adversely with variations in the microbiota

Older adults (63-76 years), gut microbiota **loses its relative stability**

Decline in immune responses and low-grade inflammatory response



The rush for sugar alternatives

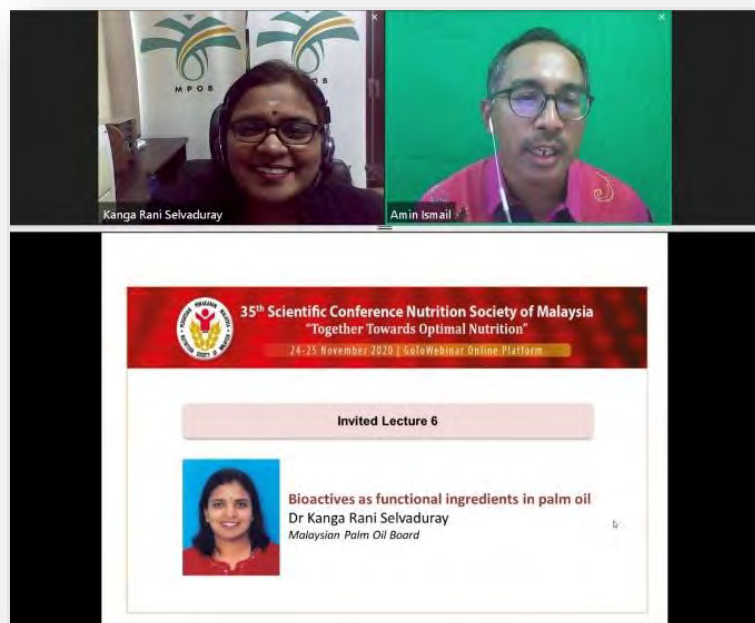


- Excessive sucrose intake causes postprandial glycaemic surge and can lead to NCD
- Sugar (sucrose) plays an indispensable role in diet
- Therefore, there is an urgent need for possible alternatives to sucrose
- IM is a promising alternative to sucrose due to its **suitable sweetness, potential physiological benefits, and feasible production processes**
